Approval of Draft Meeting Minutes from 2-26-2015

Minutes approved as submitted

AOC Re-Designation Status

- Discussion led by Ted Conlin, Ohio EPA, on the re-designation of the Black River AOC to the lower
 15 miles, which is the confluence of the East and West Branches to the mouth of the river in Lorain;
 Would also include French Creek
- Reviewed minutes and Ted's presentation from 2-26-2015 meeting and held open discussion
- Concerns, considerations, and highlights from discussion
 - If resized, the upper watershed won't be able to leverage AOC funds for projects, but there
 are other funding sources available
 - Willow Creek still has problems but wouldn't not fit in the new geographical AOC boundaries; need to make a case for inclusion in the AOC based on the impact the creek has on the river
 - Nowhere in the guidance document does it state a required width or boundary of an AOC;
 Advisory Committee needs to make a decision on the boundary and justify it in relation to BUIs

- The farther we define the boundary from the river corridor, the more difficult it is to tie back to BUIs
- We are required to complete management action plans for each BUI; there are 9 BUIs in the Black River AOC
- After discussion, the Advisory Committee took a vote on whether or not to resize the AOC
- VOTE: The Black River AOC Advisory Committee has voted to move forward with the redesignation to the AOC to the lower 15 miles of the Black River and French Creek plus the outer harbor and two Lake Erie beaches
- VOTE: The Black River AOC Advisory Committee is in favor of Ted Conlin re-writing the document to re-designate the Black River AOC to also include the mainstem HUCs and beginning the process with the Ohio and US EPA.
 - Ted said that he will would like to check with Ohio EPA and GLNPO before he starts the effort to re-write the document; the Advisory Committee agreed that this should be done
- UPDATE (4/23/15): The City of Lorain abstained from the vote during the meeting. The idea of resizing the Black River AOC was presented to the Lorain County Commissioners, and they also voted to approve the re-designation.

Next Steps for Advisory Committee

- Bylaws
 - Sub-committee already began work on bylaws
 - Will meet again to tailor bylaws to the re-designated AOC
 - Will be required to have members from government, industry/business, and citizens
- System for Letter of Support
 - o If possible, bring information to the meeting to share with group
 - When deadline prohibits this, an email will be shared and a vote taken as to whether or not to provide letter of support
