Invasive Species Removal Project Update

- Approximately 60 acres of purple loosestrife were removed
- Approximately 40 acres of phragmites were treated; approximately 12 acres that were sprayed have been cut
- Will be bringing back 6 of the workers for continuation of the project in 2014

Great Lakes National Program Office (GLNPO) Update

- Federal AOC workgroup would like to continue the work that began last year with each
 of the state AOC programs to provide support to ensure competitive project proposals
 address the critical criteria for Sustain our Great Lakes (SOGL) and NOAA habitat
 programs
- RFPs will be advertised early next year; GLNPO is looking for projects for competition either through SOGL or NOAA habitat

Willow Creek Project/Proposal

- Willow Creek is a 23-mile drainage area in the East Branch sub-basin that has low summer flow and is impacted by household sewage treatment systems, agriculture, erosion, and "sludgey" stream sediments
- Current conditions in Willow Creek could impede the delisting of BUIs in the East Branch
- Watershed Action Plan suggests non-specific remedial actions but does not state where they could be placed or have the greatest impact

 Would like to put out an RFP for environmental consulting projects for Willow Creek to identify the best areas of action for remedial efforts

Black River Video Project Update

- All interviews and footage have been transcribed by our scriptwriter, Gay Eyerman
- Should have a first draft of the script to share with EPA and Lorain County Community College shortly
- Still planning to debut the video at the Palace Theater in Lorain in early 2014

Annual Report for 2012

- Still working on the report; timeline pushed back due to change in personnel

Ashtabula River RAP

- Their advisory committee voted to proceed with the steps to remove 3 out of 6
 BUIs Fish Consumption, Fish Populations, and Fish Habitat
- A removal recommendation has been drafted and is in the final stage of approval at Ohio EPA and preliminary review state at US EPA
- Ashtabula River was designated a Priority AOC; a letter was signed that states if all management actions are done, they could potentially be delisted as an AOC
